- ♥ We are a small shelter, and may be sharing our camp room with volunteer helpers and animals, so spaces are limited. Contact us to check availability!
- ♥ **Waiting List**
This program is filled on a first-come first-served basis. However, if the camp is full, we can place you on a waiting list for a cancellation.

Drop-off is between 8:30 - 9:00 am
